RE: California Community Choice Association's Request for Extension of Time to File Advice Letter Confirming Development of Bioenergy Market Adjusting Tariff (BioMAT) Program Webpages

Dear Shawn-Dai Linderman:

This letter is in response to your February 23, 2024, e-mail on behalf of Leanne Bober, Senior Counsel for California Community Choice Association (CalCCA), requesting a two-week extension of time to comply with filing requirements directed in Ordering Paragraph (OP) 4 of Decision (D.) 23-11-084. I grant the request, as discussed below.

OP 4 of D.23-11-084 orders:

“[t]he central (Bioenergy Market Adjusting Tariff) BioMAT Accion webpage and standard framework for individual Community Choice Aggregator (CCA) webpages must be completed within 90 days of the effective date of this decision.”

In the request, CalCCA states that:

... CalCCA (on behalf of the Joint CCAs) and Accion have had meetings and exchanged questions and answers regarding the development of the central BioMAT Accion webpage, and the standard framework for individual CCA webpages. However, CalCCA has not been able to confirm with Accion whether the development of the central webpage and standard framework for individual CCA webpages will be complete by February 28, 2024.

Since CalCCA will require additional time to confirm if Accion has developed the CCA central webpage and the framework for individual CCA webpages, good cause exists that the filing deadline under OP 4 of D.23-11-084 should be extended. CalCCA's new deadline to comply with OP 4 of D.23-11-084 is March 14, 2024.

Pursuant to Rule 16.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, CalCCA must promptly inform all parties to Rulemaking 22-10-010 of the extension and must also state in the opening paragraph of that notice and in the opening paragraph of any relevant filings that the Executive Director has authorized the extension.
